**ANALYZING a CLINIC** can reveal all sorts of interesting facts. We often groan because we feel we've been dealt short shrift by some unknown judge, but the actual truth is they try to do a fair job under the pressure of time. Our last Clinic #4 was a dandy example with no less than 151 pieces of work to consider; our President instructed them that at HCC a score of 6 was to be considered the median, or average if you will. If all 3 judges gave that score to an image, you would obviously end up with 18 total, but looking at this chart shows that our final overall was 20.5, which is probably better than many of us suspected by feel only. Here are the hard facts. Makes us think again?
